Women In Distress is the only nationally accredited, state-certified, full service domestic violence center serving Broward County, Florida. ***Their mission is to stop domestic violence abuse for everyone through intervention, education and advocacy.*** Women In Distress believes that each survivor of domestic violence has the right to a safe, secure home and the capability to self-determine their violence free future. Efforts are centered on providing an environment that will help participants recover from the traumatic effects of victimization and develop an understanding and awareness of the dynamics of domestic violence by empowering them to gain independence and self-sufficiency.
