It is with great pleasure that we write this letter to inform you of a scholarship opportunity provided by the South Broward Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated. The primary purpose of this scholarship is to reward worthy and deserving African American or of African descent high school seniors with financial assistance to begin matriculation at an accredited four-year college or university. The South Broward Alumnae Chapter endeavors to encourage academic excellence, leadership, and student achievements throughout this process. Our objective is to award three scholarships, \$2000 for each recipient.

Requirements for the South Broward Alumnae Chapter Community Scholarship:

- 1. Be an African-American or of African descent male or female graduating high school senior
- Reside or attend high school within the following boundaries:
 Griffin Road (North Boundary Line); County Line Road (South boundary line); Atlantic Ocean (East boundary line); and The Florida Everglades (West boundary line)
- 3. Have applied to an accredited four-year college or university
- 4. Applicants are required to submit:
 - a. A completed legible application (typed or printed clearly) signed by Parent/Guardian
 - b. Official SEALED high school transcript
 - c. Two letters of recommendation (School Representative, Community Leader, or Civic Leader)
 - d. Proof of 100 community service hours (high school transcript or official letterhead from the service organization with original signature)
 - e. Copy of official SAT or ACT test scores
 - f. Typed essay (one page, double spaced, legible font) **Topic: The Impact of a local,** national, or international event or issue and its importance in your life.
